#### 3. Minutes

3.1 The Minutes of the Ordinary Meeting held on Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> October 2014 were agreed and signed as a true record of the meeting by the Chairman.

The meeting was suspended to allow time for the public forum. A resident volunteer from the village was present to request a donation for the East of England Ambulance Service. He is a Community First Responder and is trying to raise £554.40 for 3 pieces of equipment. This item to be on the agenda in January.

#### 4. Reports

- 4.1 **Police Report** nothing to report this month.
- 4.2 **Borough Councillor Report** The Preferred Options for the Site Allocations Document Plan was approved at Full Council on 27<sup>th</sup> November 2014. The BCKLWN Community Infrastructure Levy percentages were noted; 15% for the parish, 25% if the parish has a Neighbourhood Plan. This is an infrastructure levy that developers are charged by the BCKLWN.
- 4.3 **County Councillor Report** The new Managing Director proposes to encourage power to communities, community enablement, to encourage communities to do things for themselves. Two interim directors will be put in post, 'Community & Environment' and 'Children's Services'. There is a consultation for the budget on the website with results due back in January ready for setting the budget in February. Major plans have been approved for works to the A47 although little of it in West Norfolk there will be some work at the Broad End Road junction in Walsoken.

Change of use from service station to car wash – Filling Station, Meadowgate Lane, Emneth Clerk to write to the Highways Agency regarding concerns for road users/pedestrians with the volume of large vehicles turning right into the vehicle wash. Elizabeth Truss MP to be copied in on the correspondence.

# To consider Planning app 14/01633/O

Single building plot on land adjacent to existing dwelling at land adjacent to 54 Hollycroft Road, Emneth. On a proposal from Cllr. Waterfield, seconded by Cllr. Harper refusal of the application was recommended as part of the site is in an area designated to remain open. There is no provision for vehicles to turn within the curtilage of the host property – it is unacceptable for vehicles to reverse out onto the inside of a bend.

#### To consider Planning app 14/01635/O

Three dwellings comprising pair of semi detached house & 1 detached house with parking at 56 Elm High Road, Emneth On a proposal from Cllr. White, seconded by Cllr. Harper with 11 in favour, 1 against it was agreed to recommend refusal to the application based on over-intensive development – Council would support x1 dwelling.

# 8. Borough Council of KL & WN issues

- 8.1. Information regarding nominations for the Mayor's Civic Awards for Voluntary Service was noted.
- 8.2 2015/16 tax base & council tax support grant information was noted. The 2015/16 tax base for the parish will be 813 and the council tax support grant £1790.00. It had been previously agreed to set the precept at £28,500.00 for 2015/16 with a parish funding requirement of £26710.00 and the grant of £1790.00.

# 9. Norfolk County Council issues

- 9.1 Having now heard back from Norfolk Property Services regarding ownership of the former Wisbech Canal, High Road to Colletts Bridge it was decided that it would be of no benefit to the parish of Emneth to pursue this issue at this time. Cllr. Waterfield to action.
- 9.2 On a proposal from Cllr. Waterfield, seconded by Cllr. McCourt with 9 in favour and 3 against it was agreed to pursue the joint purchase of a SAM2 sign with Upwell & Nordelph parish councils via the 2015/16 NCC Highways Parish Partnership scheme which offers 50/50 funding for this item. Clerk to action.

10.1 A resident of Outwell Road had contacted the Clerk regarding speeding traffic/HGVs and reducing the speed limit outside her house from 50mph and/or widening the road. Clerk to action.
