# 590. Correspondence

- 590.1 An email from the Boundary Commission confirming the date of the next Parliamentary Constituency Boundary Review for 2018 was noted.
- 590.2 An email from a resident regarding parking issues around the Spar Shop area was read out & its contents noted. Clerk to reply accordingly.
- 590.3 Letter from Westcotec noted and it was agreed to accept invoicing for street light maintenance 3 monthly in arrears. Clerk to action.
- 590.4 Info from NorfolkALC on Initial training for clerks & councillors was noted.
- 590.5 Clerk provided councillors with details of the First Fenland Scout Group for Elm & Fridaybridge & Emneth who now run a group from Wales Bank, Elm.

## 591. Borough Council of KL & WN issues.

- 591.1 Concerns following the delivery of the new food waste bins and them being blown about by the wind when left by the kerbside and where to purchase additional liners for kitchen caddies had been raised. BCKLWN are recommending that the kitchen caddy be tucked behind the food bin on windy days to deter them from being blown away. The Borough are currently putting together a plan to help customers that are not near to the council offices to obtain compostable bags elsewhere and this will be in place in the next 2-3 months in local shops and/or post offices etc.
- 591.2 The Trade Refuse Agreement for the wheeled bin service was signed.
- 591.3 Information from BCKLWN regarding a scheme to reduce heating bills was noted.
- 591.4 An email from Tony Yates at BCKLWN regarding the transmission of register of electors' data electronically was noted.

## 592. Norfolk County Council issues.

- 592.1 Update on Highway Issues following a meeting with Martin Edmunds.
- A bush between the road and dyke edge, adjoining number 110 Hollycroft Road is not considered to be an obstruction onto the highway.
- The manhole behind the village hall is perhaps a little low but no repairs are necessary.
- 592.1.3 Several potholes along Elmside, Emneth have been programmed for filling.
- 592.1.4 x2 potholes along Hawthorn Road were programmed for filling.
- Top of Elmside (where it joins Hollycroft Road), the side of the road has collapsed from the use of the dust cart programmed for patching for 20m.
- 592.1.6 Pothole Church Road close to junction with Lady's Drove programmed to be done in March.
- 592.1.7 Pothole Hollycroft Close programmed to be done in March.
- 592.1.8 Flooding at Gaultree Square East at the junction with Hungate Road Martin to investigate where the drains are.
- 592.1.9 Puddles on the footpath o/s 2 Lady's Drove noted.
- 592.1.10 Large puddle at the junction of Cake Lane & Church Road Martin acknowledged that the drains here are too high. He agreed to revisit with Andy Wallace to assess.

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- 592.1.11 x3 road name plates reported that needed repairing, Lady's Drove, Bambers Lane & Outwell Road have been repaired.
- 592.1.12 Cllr. Waterfield took the information on the Norfolk Village Games.
- 592.1.13 Cllr. Terrington took the information on Local Flood Risk Management Strategy.

594.1 Cllr. Waterfield has been to BCKLWN Planning Dept. and collated all the necessary planning paperwork required for the application for QE2 status for the playing field and sent it to the Fields in Trust. The deed is now awaited.

595.2 Cllr. Waterfield has had initial enquiries with the Duty Planning Officer at BCKLWN to seek advice on a Pre-Application Enquiry for the land to the rear of the church. This should iron out any snags there might be before full planning is applied for and all the necessary searches will be made and statutory consultees consulted. Cllr. Waterfield asked for Council's approval to proceed with this enquiry – all were in favour. Cllr. Waterfield is meeting with John Maxey on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> March to measure up etc.
