1. Apologies for absence

1.1 Apologies were given for absence as listed above and accepted.

2. Declarations of Pecuniary Interest

2.1 There were no declarations of pecuniary interest made on this month's agenda.

3. Minutes

3.1 The Minutes of the AGM held on Tuesday 19th May 2015 were agreed and signed as a true record of the meeting by the Chairman.

4. Reports

4.1 **Police Report** –Cllr. Waterfield reported that following a complaint from a resident about speeding along Church Road a police camera had been deployed over the weekend of 27/28 June and 12 vehicles had been caught speeding. These drivers will be issued with a warning letter.

4.2 Borough Councillor Report -

- Cllr. Humphrey reported of an under-spend at the BCKLWN in 2014/2015. The staff have been working hard to cut costs.
- The Leisure Trust which has recently taken over the borough's leisure services has already made savings of £400,000.00.
- The Planning Inspector is currently inspecting the LDF document.
- Following the recent election, 50 out of the 64 members of the council are conservative.

4.3 County Councillor Report -

- The County Council have to find savings of £149m over the next 3 years. £150m has been saved in efficiencies and cuts in services over the last 3 years.
- Services such as waste collection, building control and payroll are shared with other councils to try and save costs.
- The Committee structure at the BCKLWN is being reviewed for its effectiveness.

9. Norfolk County Council issues

9.1 Clerk to investigate the costings with NCC Highways for the installation of a trod along Hungate Road from The Lovells to opposite the playing field in association with the 2016/17 Parish Partnership Scheme, 50/50 funding. Bids have to be in at NCC by 15 December 2015.

10. Norfolk County Council Highways Issues

- 10.1 The trees at 1 Hawthorn Road still need cutting back, from the garage to the end of the garden. Cllr. Humphrey to follow up with Highways.
- 10.2 Cllr. Humphrey to investigate the cutting back of the vegetation at the junction of Church Road with Outwell Road. A cut has been done once but it is not adequate. Visibility is still restricted when existing Church Road.

11. Footway Lighting issues
